Star Word: Grace

Epiphany Stars: Epiphany Stars are available in the Narthex throughout January. Written on each star is a gift of the Holy Spirit. Some gifts are traditional: *faith, hope* and *love*, for instance, while others might say *creativity, humor* or *simplicity*. Without peeking, pick one out of the basket randomly. Next, place the word somewhere where it can be seen – on your refrigerator, in your wallet or pocketbook, or on your desk. Then, let this word “work” on you throughout 2018. On Epiphany Sunday in January 2019 we’ll hear in worship, and in small group gatherings after worship, how God’s Spirit spoke to you through your star. The idea is that the gift written upon your star is God’s gift to you in the coming year, and in turn, your gift to God.
