Child Safety at Camp BeeTree

Your child's safety is our top priority. All volunteers are screened and a trained adult is on site each day to provide first aid or CPR if needed. Adults in all areas carry cell phones and have first aid kits nearby.

In case of thunderstorm, we will shelter in place or return to TPC. If it is raining without lightning or thunder, programming will continue at BeeTree Preserve unless it becomes unsafe to proceed.



About BeeTree Preserve

Camp BeeTree is held at BeeTree Preserve in upper Baltimore County, approximately 25mins from Towson. Owned by TPC since 1965, BeeTree Preserve features 263 beautiful acres of forests, fields, streams, and wetlands. Covered pavilions, hiking trails, bathroom facilities, and large open areas make this an ideal spot for our camp, year after year!

Secure your spot now! Camper registration involves submitting a registration form, medical form, travel consent, and check to Jenness Hall, *Director of Children, Youth, and Family Ministries*.

Counselors-in-Training (6th–12th)

Each day, they assist adult leaders, support younger Campers, facilitate activities, and go to a special midday gathering for teens. To register, prospective CITs must first submit an application. Getting Ready for Camp BeeTree

Campers should bring a backpack each day containing a bagged lunch, towel, plastic bag (to store wet swimsuit), a set of dry clothes, water bottle, and water shoes. Please write their name on all belongings!

Campers should wear a swimsuit under their clothes, sunscreen, bug spray, sneakers (no flip flops or open toe shoes), and long socks.
